Individual Annual Membership.	R750.00
10 x Independent Tierhoek Fishing Club Memberships will be available each year to non-CVC Shareholders.	
These independent members may fish any time, staying at CVC or day fishing. Any guest they bring must	
pay day fees.	
Individual Annual Membership for scholars	R500.00
Day Fees (per 5 days)	R200.00
"Paying guests" (Airbnb guests) will need to pay non-member day fees to fish Dams 1, 2, 3, 4, and Family	
Dam. Note: Only CVC Club members or guests with a CVC Club member may fish Trophy Dam.	
Syndicate Members (per cottage).	R2000.00
This fee covers all "non-paying" syndicate guests who wish to fish, with or without the individual syndicate

## TIERHOEK SYNDICATE MEMBERS

SYNDICATE MEMBERS are defined as owners/part-owners in a share of CVC Estate. One syndicate membership can be held by each cottage on the CVC Estate.

Syndicates who do not pay the annual membership fee will pay the R200 per 5-day rod fee when they or their guests fish.

Only one fish may be kept per day, per angler at an additional fee of R100 per fish. Fish may only be kept from Rainbow Dams 2, 3, and Family Dam.

#### **GENERAL FISHING RULES**

- 1. Catch and release is mandatory in Rainbow Dam 4, Rainbow Dam 1, Trophy Dam and the river.
- 2. Only recognised fly-fishing equipment may be used when fishing at Tierhoek (NO spinners, rapala's etc.) will be tolerated (excluding Family Dam). Unconventional fishing tackle may only be used should special consent be given by ALL shareholders.
- 3. Any tackle may be used at the Family Dam. Please ensure the hooks are debarbed for effective fish release. Any fish kept or that die post-release (in Family Dam) must be paid for at R100 per fish.
- 4. Only CVC Club Members or guests accompanied by members may fish trophy Dam.
- 5. No vehicles allowed on dam walls.
- 6. No swimming allowed in any of the Trout dams.
- 7. No combustion-powered boats are allowed on the dams. Only sneaker engines, kick and paddle craft are allowed.
- 8. No fishing is permitted within the Hlatikulu River inlet into the Trophy dam. In addition, the river above the syndicate dam is off-limits for fishing between the months of June to September (for the spawning season).






# TIERHOEK/CVC SYNDICATE FISHING POLICY

- AII Syndicate Members and guests <u>must</u> complete a catch return to be submitted via text or WhatsApp to the Tierhoek Fishing Syndicate WhatsApp Group when leaving the farm. This enables a digital catch register and stocking log to be maintained. Rob Rowles (072 548 1841) is the group admin on the Tierhoek WhatsApp Group.
- 10. Note: Photos of the fishing trips shared on the WhatsApp group may be used for Tierhoek's social media feeds.
- 11. After stocking, all affected dams will be closed for a 1 week period.
- Barbless flies only.
- The Manager has been delegated the authority to enforce the fishing club rules, by EXCO and the Trout Syndicate Board Members.
- The Otter's Den and Lammagai Dams (directly in front of Otters Den and Lammagai Cottage's) are stocked privately, separate to the club dams. These two small dams are for Otter's Den and Lammagai guests only.
